The main text of the abstract (excluding title and authors) must not exceed 250 words. Arial, 12-point font size, single spacing only, leave a line gap between paragraphs to aid reading. Type or paste your text into this file, the page margins have been set at 2.54 cm. Paragraphs are justified (straight-edged) on both left and right.

The abstract text should clearly describe the study/case, results and conclusions. Headings within the text are unnecessary. Abbreviations must be defined. Statistical tests used must be specified. References can be used if considered vital but will contribute to the 250 word count.

Figures are not allowed. A single table can be presented (maximum 5 rows by 5 columns) but will be considered 100 words. The limit for the abstract is one A4 page.

The presenter is responsible for the content of the abstract and assuring that all authors have been informed of the presentation and have agreed the data submitted.
