## POSTERS - CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

- The Academy invites BioMedica delegates who wish to present their work as a poster at BioMedica to submit an abstract for consideration.
- Abstracts are welcome in all fields of blood transfusion, cellular pathology, clinical chemistry, haematology, immunology, microbiology, virology and in the broader fields of laboratory medicine e.g. demand management, preanalytical phase, Greenlabs.
- All members undertaking any research or development work in their laboratory are encouraged to participate in this poster display.
- Submitters of abstracts must be prepared to present in poster format (portrait) during BioMedica
- To compete in the poster competition at least one of the authors submitting an abstract must be a member of the Academy or a paying delegate at BioMedica2023.
- The closing date for acceptance of abstracts is February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023. Please email abstracts to [mail@acslm.ie](mailto:mail@acslm.ie) with **Poster Abstract – BioMedica** on the subject line.
- A pre-selection will be made on the abstracts due to limited space for presentation. Submitters will be informed by email if selected.
- Posters should be in place by midday on **Monday March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at the CCD centre**. Judging will take place from then.

## HOW TO PREPARE YOUR ABSTRACT

1. Abstracts must be typed single spaced.
2. Abstracts must not exceed 300 words (this does not include the title, author details and tables) and have only one table.
3. The abstract title may not contain any trade names.
4. Selected abstracts will be published in Converse as submitted.
5. Capitalise the entire title and do not abbreviate.
6. Under the title, all contributing authors should be listed.
7. The text should be arranged as follows without the use of subtitles.
  - a) Introduction/background
  - b) Aims
  - c) Materials and Methods
  - d) Summary of results
  - e) Conclusions (it is not satisfactory to state, 'the conclusions will be discussed').
  - f) Use standard abbreviations.
  - d) References (no more than three) should be listed numerically in the text and then placed at the bottom of the text using a standard format.
